- · Writing for purpose (skills for fiction and non-fiction writing)
- AQA Papers 1 and 2, both Questions 4 (evaluation and comparison)
- Edexcel Transactional Writing
- AQA Paper 2 Writers' Viewpoints and Perspectives

GCSE Maths

Use the workshops as a way of introducing new topics or embedding skills already taught. Again, workshops can be focused on broad topics (e.g. Geometry and Measure) or a mixture of specific sub-topics. Here are some workshops delivered last academic year:

- Ratio, Proportion and rates of change (Higher)
- Fractions, standard form, averages and percentages (Foundation)
- 2D shapes, angles, transformations (Foundation)
- Trigonometry, surds, real life graphs, similar shapes, iteration (Higher)
